

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the average amount of time for renting a roll-off container?

- The average amount of time is 7 days. The rate is \$10 per day thereafter.

Do the terms "roll-off", "container", and "dumpster" all mean the same?

- Yes

What dumpster sizes do you offer?

- 12-Yard Roll-Off - 12 feet long x 8 feet wide x 4 feet high
- 15-Yard Roll-Off - 16 feet long x 8 feet wide x 4 feet high
- 20-Yard Roll-Off - 16 feet long x 8 feet wide x 5.5 feet high
- 30-Yard Roll-Off - 18 feet long x 8 feet wide x 6 feet high
- 40-Yard Roll-Off - 22 feet long x 8 feet wide x 6.5 feet high

What is not allowed in the dumpsters?

- Tires, paint, batteries, hazardous waste and nothing containing refrigeration are examples of what is not allowed in the dumpsters. A full list of prohibited items will be included on your contract.

Can household debris be mixed with construction debris?

- Typically household debris should not be combined with construction debris. Household debris is accepted at a sanitary landfill which charges by weight. Because construction debris tends to be heavier than household debris, costs for disposal would be higher.

Will the container be automatically picked up after seven days?

- No. We will only pick up the container when you call.

Do you actually pick up and deliver containers seven days a week and on holidays?

- Yes!

Does each roll-off container have a tailgate?

- Yes. All containers have a tailgate which opens to the left.

Do I pay when you pick up the dumpster or when you drop off the dumpster?

- We accept payment when the dumpster is dropped off.

What does "CD materials" stand for?

- That term refers to construction debris materials.
