THE MOST DIFFICULT COMMAND (Part 2) Josue Ramirez

Last week we explored why repentance is the most difficult command in Scripture (Acts 17:30). This week we look at three obstacles that keep people from repenting — and how God helps us overcome them.

1. Some Don't Repent Because They Don't Realize They Are Sinners

They compare themselves to others and conclude they are "good enough." But the real question is not, "Am I as good as others?" It is, "Am I a sinner?" Scripture answers plainly: "For all have sinned" (Romans 3:23).

Religious activity alone cannot save (Matthew 15:9; John 14:6). We must follow the gospel plan: hearing (Romans 10:17), believing (John 3:16), repenting (Acts 2:38), confessing (Acts 8:37), and being baptized (Mark 16:16).

2. Some Don't Repent Because of Pride

Jesus warned of those who "trusted in themselves" (Luke 18:9-14). Pride is deadly: "Pride get before destruction" (Proverbs 16:18). We must care more about what God thinks than what others think.

3. Some Don't Repent Because They Love a Certain Sin Too Much

The gate to heaven is narrow (Luke 13:23-24). Some refuse to give up gambling, adultery, alcohol, or other sins. Like the rich young ruler, they "go away sorrowful" (Matthew 19:16-22).

A Story to Remember

A little girl treasured her dime-store pearl necklace. Her father asked for it several nights in a row. She refused — until one night she tearfully handed it over. Her father then gave her a velvet box containing real pearls. God is like that father. He asks us to give up the cheap imitation so He can give us the real treasure.

"He that covered his sins shall not prosper but who-so confessed and forsakes them shall have mercy" (Proverbs 28:13).

The question, God has His hand extended. Are you willing to trade?

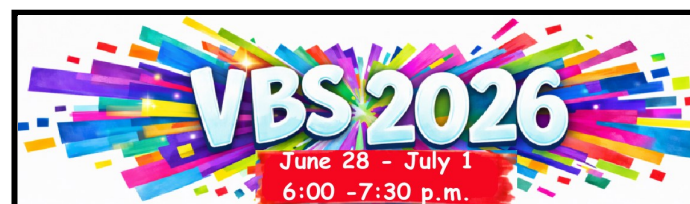
