The X Human Relationship Rules
Josue Ramirez

The following article is a continuation of the last three human relationships rules or commandments viewed in the last edition. RECAP

- I. Thou Shalt Love People, Not Just Use Them (Matthew 22:39).**
- II. Thou Shalt Develop Thine Understanding (Matthew 7:12; 1 Peter 3:7).**
- III. Thou Shalt Compliment More Than Criticize (1 Peter 3:10; Romans 14:19).**

Here are the next four rules of the TEN Human Relationships.

IV. Thou Shalt Not Often Get Angry (Ephesians 4:26).

Anger is a natural emotion, but when it becomes frequent or uncontrolled, it can lead to sin and broken relationships. This principle reminds us that: *“If we are right, we do not need to. If we are wrong, we cannot afford to.”* This quote is both sobering and wise. When we are right, truth speaks for itself—anger only clouds it. When we are wrong, anger becomes a shield for pride, preventing growth and reconciliation.

V. Thou Shalt Not Argue (Ephesians 4:32).

Arguments often stem from a desire to be right rather than to be reconciled. This principle teaches that: *“It is no use to win the argument and lose the relationship.”* And this quote: *“In matters controversial, my attitude is fine. I always see two points of view—the one that is wrong and mine.”* exposes the pride that can blind us to others' perspectives. True wisdom listens, seeks understanding, and values connection over conquest.

VI. Thou Shalt Be Kind (1 Corinthians 13:4).

Kindness is the outward expression of love. It costs nothing but means everything. The following quotes are rich with wisdom: *“Be kind to people you meet on the way up; they are the ones you meet on the way down.”* *“It is nice to be important, but it is more important to be nice.”* These remind us that status is fleeting, but character endures. Kindness builds bridges, softens hearts, and reflects the love of Christ.

VII. Thou Shalt Have a Sense of Humor (Proverbs 17:22).

A sense of humor is a gift—it lightens burdens, strengthens relationships, and brings healing. The analogy, *“A sense of humor is to a man what springs are to a wagon. It saves him lots of jolts.”*, beautifully illustrates how humor cushions life's bumps. It doesn't remove hardship, but it helps us bear it with grace and resilience. In these four rules of human relationships, the importance of self-control with anger and self-justification, to prove our own point of view, is needed with kindness when it comes to any human relationship. Life needs a seasoning and humor can season ours. Next edition, we'll look onto the last three rules of human relationships.
