## THE MOST DIFFICULT COMMAND

(Part 1) Josue Ramirez

Is the hardest command in Scripture to “love your neighbor as yourself” (Luke 10:27)? To be “pure in heart” (Matthew 5:8)? To “flee fornication” (1 Corinthians 6:18)? To “repent and be baptized” (Acts 2:38)? To “love your enemies” (Matthew 5:44)? These are challenging, but none of them is the hardest.

According to Acts 17:30, “God... now commanded all men everywhere to repent.” Repentance is the most difficult command because it requires something we resist: change.

J. W. McGarvey once said that if God were giving miraculous gifts today, he would not ask for healing or prophecy — he would ask for the power to make people repent. Why? Because people do not change easily. Repentance means admitting we are wrong, turning from sin, and surrendering our will to God.

### What Repentance Really Is

Repentance includes three essential elements:

A change of mind “As he thinketh in his heart, so is he” (Proverbs 23:7). Isaiah says the unrighteous man must “forsake his thoughts” (Isaiah 55:7).

Produced by godly sorrow Paul wrote, “Godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of” (2 Corinthians 7:9–10).

Resulting in a reformed life We cannot relive yesterday, but we can obey today (Romans 6:13).

A little girl once said repentance is “being sorry enough to quit.” That’s exactly right. True repentance is not a dusting — it is a washing (Psalm 51:2; Acts 22:16).

### Why Repent?

To be saved (Acts 2:38; Luke 13:3). To enjoy abundant life now (John 10:10). To restore purpose and usefulness (Luke 15:11–32).

Like the silver cup dissolved in acid and recovered by a master chemist, repentance allows God to recover our value and reshape us into His image (Colossians 3:10).
